The 30th annual Keene 4th of July Parade starts at 9:00 AM along a new route beginning at Old Betsy Road and 4th Streets, proceeding north to Magnolia. Staging is at Pinnacle Bank for vehicles and at Chisholm Trail Academy for animals. Parade registration (\$10) opens at 7:30 AM on the bank's south entrance. Entries must be registered by 8:00 AM to be judged. Registration is open until 8:50 AM. The parade theme is "Happy Birthday, America." Judging will take place before the parade. First-place ribbons will be awarded in these categories: All-terrain Vehicle; Decorated 4-Wheel Vehicle; Decorated 2-Wheel Entry; Decorated Antique Vehicle; Decorated Float; Animal Entry (non-equestrian); Horse Entry; Business Entry; Children's Entry. A special viewing area for veterans will be located along Old Betsy Road in front of Pinnacle Bank.
